NHRTL-PAC Reports on Manchester Election

The NHRTL Political Action Committee confidently recommends voters elect **Richard H. Girard** for Mayor of Manchester on Tuesday, November 6. "Rich Girard answered 12 questions on the NHRTL-PAC survey 100% pro-life, while the current mayor, Bob Baines, didn't even bother to reply," said NHRTL-PAC Chairman Ed Holdgate. "Rich Girard made a difference in the effort to restore a pro-life CMC hospital, but Bob Baines has given wink-and-nod help to the controversial Planned Parenthood abortion clinic still unopened on Pennacook Street.
