



NHRTL-PAC '24 NH GENERAL VOTING GUIDE

NH Right to Life Political Action Committee (NHRTL PAC) makes available this 2024 NH General Election Voting Guide to assist life-minded voters in choosing candidates for the state offices of Governor, Executive Councilor, State Senator, and State Representative.

NHRTL PAC urges conscientious pro-lifers to support the below candidates on Election Day Tuesday, November 5, 2024.

Recommendations are:

- **Endorse:** NHRTL-PAC's highest recommendation. A candidate has affirmed that they are strongly pro-life through a survey or voting record. We believe endorsed candidates will defend all human life without exception.
- **Support:** candidates that we didn't endorse, but whom we believe would be the most life-affirming choice in a particular race. Note that this depends heavily on the context of the race and could mean that a candidate is strongly pro-life or that they simply don't openly advocate for legalizing the abortion of 7 and 8 month children or assisted suicide.
- **Oppose:** candidates who want to legalize the aborting of children at 7, 8, and 9 months by seeking to repeal the Fetal Life Protection Act (which protects children at 6 months/24 weeks) or otherwise negate its protections (e.g. CACR23 and CACR24)
- **Unknown:** candidates for whom we do not have sufficient information.

Information used in this voter guide came from various sources, including our own survey, voting records, and public statements. Only a views on protecting life are considered.

To save space, we omit candidates in uncontested races where we have no recommendation and races where we can recommend sufficient candidates for every opening. In other cases (especially when candidate views were unknown), we include the information we have.

Note: Every incumbent NH Democrat legislator who has voted, has voted to legalize the aborting of children at 7 and 8 months, denying any rights to a child who is ready to survive outside the womb.

GOVERNOR

Candidate	Recommendation
Kelly Ayotte	Support. Kelly Ayotte has publicly stated that she would veto any changes to NH's 6 month protection for preborn children (the Fetal Life Protection Act), whether to protect more children or to remove it. (Boston Globe, 6/14/24)
Joyce Craig	Oppose. Joyce Craig has said that she would remove NH's protection for preborn children. She would also like to add onerous regulations targeting charities that support pregnant women. [website]

EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

The Executive Council (EC) has several responsibilities, which include approving contracts for the state. Over the past year, the EC upheld the legislature's ban on most tax monies going to abortion providers.

Note: All Democrat EC candidates have pledged to subsidize abortion providers with tax dollars.

STATE REPRESENTATIVES/STATE HOUSE

Note: Every incumbent Democratic State Representative who has voted on the issue, voted to legalize the aborting of 7, 8, and 9 month children (2023 HB224, HB271, or 2024 CACR23). CACR23 could have open the door to forced abortions according to a former Chief Justice of the NH Supreme Court.

While CACR23 had a provision that only allowed abortions past 24 weeks if needed in the opinion of a physician, the protection effectively allowed abortions at any time since several abortionists have stated that abortion should always be an option.
